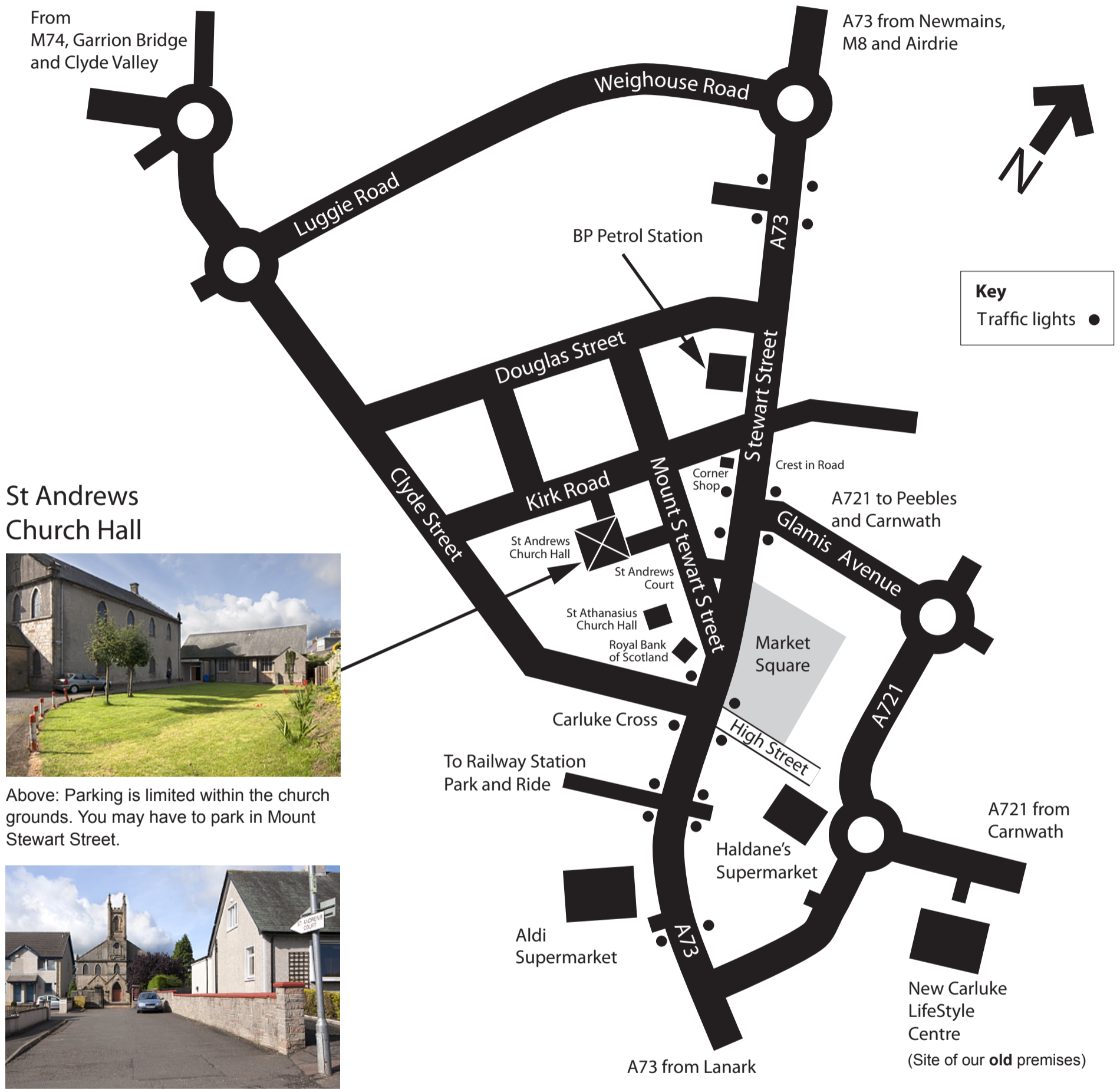


Carluk Camera Club Location Plan

St Andrews Church Hall



Above: Parking is limited within the church grounds. You may have to park in Mount Stewart Street.



Above: It is probably easiest to access St Andrews Church grounds from Mount Stewart Street as the church is quite visible from this side.



Above: The access from Kirk Road is easily missed, especially in the dark, as it looks like a hedge-lined private driveway.

For those unfamiliar with St Andrews Church, enter from Mount Stewart Street rather than Kirk Road. Beware of the narrow access.

If coming from Newmains, M8 and Airdrie on the A73

On entering Carluk go straight through the roundabout and the first traffic lights. Turn right after the BP petrol Station at the corner shop into Kirk Road. Turn left at the crossroads into Mount Stewart Street. The entrance to the Church is the first on the right thereafter, via St. Andrews Court.

If coming from the M74, Garrion Bridge and the Clyde Valley

Follow the main road through the first roundabout and straight on through the second roundabout into Clyde Street. Turn left at the traffic lights (Carluk Cross) and immediately bear left into Mount Stewart Street. The entrance to the Church Hall is on the left via St. Andrews Court.

If coming from Lanark on the A73

Proceed through Braidwood into Carluk, past the Aldi supermarket and through the lights that lead down to Carluk Station and the Park and Ride. Pass through the next traffic lights at Carluk Cross (the Royal Bank of Scotland is on the left) and immediately bear left into Mount Stewart Street. The entrance to the Church Hall is on the left via St. Andrews Court.
